11. The court voted to replace the flooring in the Tax Office in Copperas Cove after a motion by Commissioner Daren Moore and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham.

12. The court discussed a process procedure, interview board and date for maintenance manager position.

13. The court discussed action on the copier contract.

14. The court discussed modifying the county's contribution to family, spouse or children insurance plan and other insurance modifications. No Action was taken.

15. The court approved electrical outlets and an irrigation system for the Courthouse after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Daren Moore.

16. The court voted to send inmate laundry to Valet Cleaners for a two week period to test the cost after a motion by Commissioner Daren Moore and a second by Commissioner Ray Ashby.


