Jerry Seagraves spoke about CR 142; he agrees with the speed limit being reduced and request the presence of the Sheriff's Office with radar for a couple of weeks after it is changed. 13. The Court will address the request from Turnersville Volunteer Fire Department for funds to build a brush truck during budget season after a motion by Commissioner Ray Ashby and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham.

14. The Court approved reallocating a 2009 Pierce Contender fire engine from Copperas Cove to Coryell City/Osage Volunteer Fire Department after a motion from Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ray Ashby.

The Court approved allotting \$500,000 to Copperas Cove, \$500,000 to Gatesville and \$650,000 to Road and Bridge Department for future projects funded by the Community Development Block Grant-Mitigation (CDBG-MIT) after a motion by Commissioner Ryan Basham and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews.
