6. The Court accepted the work summary from the Road and Bridge Department for May 2022 after a motion by Commissioner Ray Ashby and a second from Commissioner Kyle Matthews. (Attached)

7. Discussion was held on this item.

8. Bob Harrell, Emergency Management Coordinator, gave an update on Coronavirus (COVID-19).

9. The Court approved the agreement with Natural Resource Solutions for data, analysis, and technical assistance to support a transportation planning grant under the US Department of Transportation Safe Streets and Roads for All Grant Program after a motion by Commissioner Ryan Basham and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews.

10. The Court prohibited the use of any type of fireworks in Coryell County, no restrictions were placed on the sale of fireworks, and only authorized, permitted, insured and bonded companies can provide firework displays within the municipalities; this is extended until the current burn ban is expired after a motion by Commissioner Ryan Basham and a second by Commissioner Ray Ashby.

11. The Court tabled this item after a motion by Commissioner Ray Ashby and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews.

12. Discussion was held with no action being taken on this item.

13. The Court approved the Memorandum of Understanding with Gatesville Independent School District for School-Community Guidance Center (SCGC) after a motion by Commissioner Ryan Basham and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews.



18. The Court approved Court Order 2022-20 Surplus Property from the Juvenile Probation Department after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham.
19. The Court approved the revised contract with The Cleaning Magical Hands, Inc. with the corrections being made to the payment section and changing "Parole" to "Probation" after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham.




 KYLE MATTHEWS, PRECINCT 1
