8. The Court approved removing a portion of Old Pidcoke Road, which has been annexed by the City of Gatesville, from the county maintenance list after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor. (Attached)

9. Updates on grants were given:

- b. HMP- Documents are in order, waiting to hear back if our in-kind form will be sufficient.
- c. RCP- MRB is set up on the portal so documents can be submitted, the Court needs to start working on the higher-level issues within the subdivision regulations which is the next step for this grant process.
- d. CDBG-MIT- No updates available.
- e. FEMA RPA-DR 4781- Recovery scoping meeting was held, the 60-day window has started for the damage to be reported, inspections are taking place with site visits, and a mitigation list is being made.

12. The Court ratified the application for Unclaimed Property Capital Credits for Counties after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham. (Attached)

13. The Court approved an election to be held on November 5, 2024 in Coryell County, Texas after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor. (Attached)

14. The Court selected Option A-No Change for the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles County Fees for calendar year 2025 after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor. (Attached)

15. The Court approved the budget and tax rate adoption timeline after a motion by Commissioner Scott Weddle and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews. Commissioner Kyle Matthews rescinded his second to this motion.

The Court adopted the budget and tax rate adoption timeline with a hearing on the budget to be held on September 5, 2024, publish of the notice of the hearing no later than August 24, 2024 and at the same time a notice of a proposed tax rate after a motion by Commissioner Scott Weddle and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews. 16. I move to propose the 2024 property tax rate of \$.4737 per \$100 in valuation. The rate shall be broken down in the following; \$.42846 per \$100 for the purpose of maintenance and operations and; \$.04524 per \$100 for the purpose of principal and interest on debts, motion made by County Judge Roger Miller and a second by Commissioner Scott Weddle.

A roll call vote was taken to propose a tax rate to support the FY2025 budget and the votes are as follows:

Commissioner Keith Taylor: Yes
Commissioner Scott Weddle: No

With 3 Ayes and 2 No; Ayes have it and the motion carries.

17. The Court tabled the salary schedule for 2025 until the next available meeting after a motion by Commissioner Scott Weddle and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor.

18. The Court approved health plan alternate 1 with 60/40 split after a motion by Commissioner Keith Taylor and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews. Votes were taken and are as follows: Commissioner Kyle Matthews, Commissioner Keith Taylor, and Commissioner Scott Weddle voted Yes. Commissioner Ryan Basham voted No.

19. The Court voted to pay bills in the amount of \$2,353,675.96 after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor. (Attached)

This meeting was adjourned at 3:52 p.m.



KYLE MATTHEWS, PRECINCT 1




RYAN BASHAM, PRECINCT 3
