**ORDER AUTHORIZING THE BURNING OF VEGETATION BY THE CORYELL COUNTY
ROAD AND BRIDGE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Coryell County passed and approved Order CC25-01 on March 25, 2025, which prohibited the outdoor burning of brush, trash and debris in the unincorporated areas of Coryell County; and,

WHEREAS, Coryell County was subject to a natural disaster resulting from the spring storms of 2024, later identified as DR4781; and,

WHEREAS, Coryell County had to take actions to remove debris and vegetation to ensure the safe and secure travel of citizens on County Roads; and,

WHEREAS, a necessity exists to eliminate these piles of vegetation; and,

WHEREAS, the County Judge is authorized to make a determination, and now finds that environmental circumstances are conducive for the limited, controlled burning of vegetation resulting from DR4781; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the County Judge of Coryell County that the Coryell County Road and Bridge Department is authorized to conduct controlled burning of piles of vegetation, accumulated due to DR4781, beginning at 7:00am on April 7, 2025, and ending at 8:00pm on April 11, 2025.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the County Road and Bridge Department shall actively monitor each burn site and have the appropriate personnel and water available to contend with the burning of the vegetation. And that Court Order CC25-01 remains in effect for the unincorporated areas of Coryell County.
