8. The Court approved the Invitation to Bid, Bridge 2022-01, after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham.

9. The Court approved the plat for Rock Creek Estates after a motion by Commissioner Ryan Basham and a second by Commissioner Ray Ashby.

10. The Court approved Resolution 2022-04, Request to Transfer Road Maintenance of Veterans Memorial Drive F/K/A Complex Circle to the City of Gatesville, after a motion by Commissioner Ryan Basham and a second by Commissioner Ray Ashby. (Attached)

11. The Court will continue to convene Commissioners Court the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of each month during the next fiscal year after a motion by Commissioner Ryan Basham and a second by Commissioner Scott Weddle.

12. The Court approved the County Holiday Schedule FY2023 after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham. (Attached)

13. The Court approved the Sheriff's and Constables' fees for service to be effective January 1, 2023 with the changes noted after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ray Ashby.

14. The Court approved Resolution 2022-05, Authorizing a County Grant to Hill Country Community Action Association (home delivered meals program grant), after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham.

15. The Court approved Court Order 2022-25 Salvage/Surplus Equipment for Juvenile Probation Office after a motion by Commissioner Ryan Basham and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews. (Attached)

16. Steve Manning from NRS gave an update on the current grant applications and future grant opportunities.

17. The Court approved creating a committee consisting of representatives from the following agencies; Road and Bridge, Emergency Management Coordinator, Fire, Law Enforcement, Independent School Districts and Middle Trinity, to facilitate the collection, prioritization and organization of data for a County Geographic Information System (GIS) database after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham.

The Court authorized Mr. Hefflefinger with Southwest Architects to move forward with contacting Mr.Kriegel in order to survey the county's property at 5th and Leon and topography for the use of parking and possible detention; authorized Mr. Belt to contact the City of Gatesville and issue a letter regarding the drainage at 5th Street and Main Street and send a letter to the Board of Adjustments after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham.

19. The Court approved the revised building plans for the government building presented by Southwest Architects after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ray Ashby. (Attached)

20. The Court approved an increase in rates with Mills County from \$50.00 to \$75.00 per day per inmate after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham.

21. The Court authorized the County Attorney to work with the Sheriff to draft a response related to the Attorney General's second letter regarding non-compliance with the Texas Commission on Jail Standards after a motion by Commissioner Scott Weddle and a second by Commissioner Ray Ashby.

The Court approved an Interlocal Agreement with Haskell County for housing out of county inmates at a rate of \$95.00 per day after a motion by Commissioner Ray Ashby and a second of Commissioner Ryan Basham. (Attached)


