7. Updates on grants were given:

- a. SS4A- Still trying to recoup previous funds and in the process of submitting the third project (Cottonwood Creek at Bald Knob).
- b. HMP- Reimbursement phase.
- c. RCP- Miller contacted MRB to assume the grant management per contract.
- d. CDBG-MIT- No new updates.
- e. FEMA RPA-DR 4781- There is conflict between how we track and group them versus how FEMA wants the projects tracked and grouped, CAT A needs to be verified, portions of CAT B have been taking care of, and CAT C is still evolving.
- f. LCFP- In the next few weeks there will be 14 additional gauges placed in the full study area, a will attend meeting will need to be held.




16. A workshop was held and discussion took place concerning County owned buildings and facilities.


