The Coryell County Commissioners' Court convened at 9:07 a.m. with all members present. County Judge, Roger Miller gave the invocation and led the Pledge to the American and Texas Flags.

 - a. The Court accepted the June 2025 Financial Summary report by the County Tax Assessor.
 - b. The Court accepted the minutes from the Historical Commission meeting held on June 18, 2025.
 - c. The Court approved the minutes for the Commissioners Court meeting held on June 24, 2025.

The consent agenda was approved after a motion by Commissioner Ryan Basham and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor.

6. The Road & Bridge report was not given.

7. Updates on grants were given:

- a. RCP- Another workshop needs to be held
- b. CDBG-MIT- Kick off meeting happening next week for CR274, Bald Knob, Copperas Cove, and Gatesville projects.
- c. FEMA RPA-DR 4781- FEMA canceled the meeting last week, there is a meeting scheduled for next Tuesday to finalize category c, scope, and cost on the mitigation projects.

8. The Court approved Court Order 2025-05, Order Confirming and Validating Court Order 2020-09 (Order Authorizing Credit Card Indebtedness), after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor. (Attached)

9. The Court tabled setting salaries, expenses, and allowances of Elected Officials for FY2026 until later in the meeting after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham.

Commissioner Scott Weddle made a motion that for the FY2026 budget we do not raise the county supplement. Motion died due to lack of second.

The Court tabled setting salaries, expenses, and allowances of Elected Officials for FY2026 until 1:30 p.m. after a motion by Commissioner Ryan Basham and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews.

The Court will move forward with posting the salaries of the Elected Officials as presented and amended noting that the court elected not to increase the county supplement from \$18,000 to \$25,000 after a motion by Commissioner Scott Weddle and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews.

10. The Court approved the submission of the County Feral Hog Grant Program after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor. (Attached)

11. The Court accepted a donation of a drone and charger (Model DJI Mini 2), Batteries (Model BWX161-2250-7.7) and controller (Model RC231) from Coryell County Sheriff Deputy Joseph Meyers after a motion by Commissioner Ryan Basham and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews. (Attached)

12. The Court approved entering into contract with Tango Tango using Senate Bill 22 funds after a motion by Commissioner Scott Weddle and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews.

13. The Court authorized the purchase of Motorola radios from Sunny Communications, LLC 25 using Senate Bill 22 funds after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham.

14. The Court approved the RFP 25-04 for Managed IT Services with a correction being made to page 5 changing the extension from 310 to 301 after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor. (Attached)

15. The Court approved an Interlocal Agreement with Lampasas County on approval and oversight of Clear Creek Estates Subdivision, Section III, Phase V after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham. (Attached)

16. Discussion was held regarding RFP 25-03 County Health Insurance.

17. The Court approved to engage into negotiations with Curative for county health insurance after a motion by Commissioner Scott Weddle and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor.

18. The Court voted to pay bills in the amount of \$1,531,842.82 after a motion by Commissioner Scott Weddle and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews. (Attached)


20. Report was not given.

This meeting was adjourned at 2:18 p.m.




