 - d. FEMA RPA-DR 4781- Forced account projects are in the CRC stage for review, now scoping out individual projects, mainly working on low water crossings and bridges, a few projects have been removed and placed under other grant opportunities.
 - e. LCFP- Still on track to get the flood sensors put in within the next 30-60 days.






KYLE MATTHEWS, PRECINCT 1
