ORDER PROVIDING FOR THE DELAYED OPENING OF COUNTY BUILDINGS

WHEREAS, the Texas State Constitution grants a County Judge broad administrative authority; and,

WHEREAS, severe winter weather is expected to have adverse effects on the safe travel of County, State, and Federal roadways in Coryell County; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the County Judge of Coryell County that County buildings will have a delayed opening to the public subject to the following dates and times:

1. County buildings will open at 0900 on 26 January, 2026; a delay of one (1) hour..
2. Full-time, non-exempt County employees, who are scheduled to work on 26 January, 2026, from 0800-0900, as part of their normally scheduled hours, and do not work due to this order, shall be granted one (1) hour of administrative time for the affected pay period.
3. Nothing in this Order shall be construed to impair or infringe upon the authorities granted to any other Elected Official in Coryell County.
