CDBG-MIT- Meeting held on January 5, 2026, approaching the sixty percent engineering phase on the four projects, within the next 60 days the engineering plans will be brought to court at which time they will approve or reconfigure the designs before sending them out for bid. The third reimbursement was submitted last week for \$35,000.
 - d. FEMA RPA-DR 4781- Signed off and submitted to TDEM a reimbursement for approximately \$799,500.00.
 - e. LCFP- No new updates.
