7. Sam Goldsmith provided an update on Information Technology operations. The update included a review of the technology life cycle, computer and server asset inventory, and a breakdown of current equipment and infrastructure needs. (Attached)

- a. HMP- We still do not have access to the Tiger portal. Once access is granted, the documents will be uploaded and reimbursement processing will proceed.
 - b. RCP- No new updates.
 - c. CDBG-MIT- No new updates.
 - d. FEMA RPA-DR 4781- Judge Miller has received some of the paperwork for reimbursements.
 - e. LCFP- 3 additional gauges have been activated at table rock creek, beehouse and slater road, the live feed will be available through the county website.

18. The Court authorized demand be made and, if necessary, suit be brought against Harco National Insurance Company to enforce the performance bond it issued for its principal TX Conservation, LLC. After a motion by Commissioner Keith Taylor and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews.


