The Coryell County Commissioners' Court convened at 9:03 a.m. with a quorum present. Commissioner Ryan Basham gave the invocation and Judge Roger Miller led the Pledge to the American and Texas Flags.

- a. The Court accepted the March 2026 Financial Summary report from the Treasurer's Office.
 - b. The Court accepted the April 2026 Financial Summary report from the Tax Assessor's Office.
 - c. The Court accepted the April 2026 Financial Summary report from the County Judge's Office.
 - d. The Court accepted the minutes for the Historical Commission meeting held on April 8, 2026.
 - e. The Court approved the minutes for the Commissioners' Court meeting held on May 12, 2026.

The consent agenda was approved after a motion by Commissioner Ryan Basham and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor.

6. Justin Latham, Road and Bridge administrator, gave the report.

7. The Court tabled the Resolution supporting in-kind match for off system bridges after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor.

8. The Court tabled the Advanced Funding Agreement for bridge replacement on Neff Park Road after a motion by Commissioner Ryan Basham and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews.

9. The Court approved the Advanced Funding Agreement for bridge replacement on Bull Branch Road after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham.

10. The Court approved the Coleman Subdivision plat after a motion by Commissioner Keith Taylor and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews.

11. An update regarding IT services was given
- a. The Court approved the agreement with Kings III Emergency Communications for elevator telephone communications after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham.
 - b. The Court approved the agreement with Brightspeed for Internet Services after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor. (Attached)

 - e. LCFP- Setting up a workshop with Blackland.

14. The Court reappointed Ray Ashby to a two-year term on the Board of Trustees for Central Counties Services after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor.

15. The Court approved Court Order CC26-04; Order Declaring Equipment/Property Surplus/Salvage after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham. (Attached)

16. The Court tabled the consideration of a court order for court bailiff vehicles to be used for work only not commuting after a motion by Commissioner Keith Taylor and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews.

17. No action taken regarding a court order that Sheriff's Office take home vehicles only be used for commuting to residences within the county.

18. The Court approved the request from the Gatesville Chamber of Commerce for the use of the Coryell County properties identified in their letter in conjunction with the Shivaree event after a motion by Commissioner Keith Taylor and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham.

19. No action taken regarding the process to move forward with the former Coryell County Hospital property to sell located at 1109 Saunders.

20. The Court voted to extend the lease at 113 S. 7th Street, Gatesville until September 17, 2026 after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor.

21. The Court voted to pay bills in the amount of \$1,906,690.78 after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor. (Attached)

26. The Court suspended the actions for demand on the performance bond for the Hidden Creek Subdivision until June 23, 2026 after a motion Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham.

27. No action taken regarding the action to settle claim against Coryell County and the Coryell County Sheriff's Office.

28. The Court adopted the procedure to lease real property by publishing notice of intent to lease in the newspaper on two dates, with the second date occurring at least fourteen days before the award is made, and shall describe the real property and include the procedure for receipt and consideration of the lease proposals pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 263.007 and authorizing the notice for call

for bids on the property located at 712 Bridge St, Gatesville, TX after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor.

29. The Court authorized the County Attorney to engage with outside counsel on the economic development of the VA Clinic in Copperas Cove, Texas after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham.




