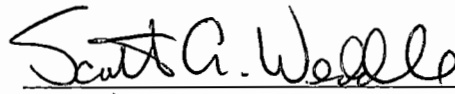

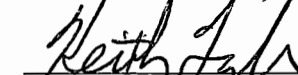
KYLE MATTHEWS, PRECINCT 1



RYAN BASHAM, PRECINCT 3

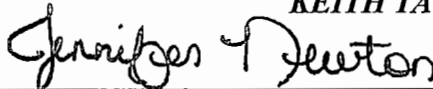


SCOTT WEDDLE, PRECINCT 2
