 - b. The Court accepted the June 2026 Financial Summary report from the Tax Assessor's Office.
 - c. The Court approved the minutes for the Commissioners' Court meeting held on June 23, 2026.
- The consent agenda was approved after a motion by Commissioner Ryan Basham and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor.
6. The Court accepted the Road and Bridge work summary for June 2026 after motion by Commissioner Ryan Basham and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews. (Attached)
7. The Court denied the exception to the platting requirements for property ID #149461 or address 4217 W. FM 217, Gatesville, TX 76528 after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor.
8. The Court ordered the release of the maintenance bond on Cedar Bluff subdivision after a motion by Commissioner Keith Taylor and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews.
9. The Court accepted Cedar Bluff Loop and Cedar Hill Dr. roads from the Cedar Bluff subdivision into the county system for road maintenance after a motion by Commissioner Keith Taylor and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews. (Need signed order)
10. The Court will call the bond on the Hidden Creek subdivision after a motion by Commissioner Ryan Basham and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor.
11. Discussion/update was held regarding the transition of IT services.
12. Updates on grants were given:
 - a. HMP- There were fourteen documents uploaded into the TIGR system along with the request for payment and grant closeout report.
 - b. RCP- A new grant administrator was assigned at the GLO. A call is being coordinated for the status and update of the grant.
 - c. CDBG-MIT- Walker Partners is to give a start date with the revised coordinates.
 - d. FEMA RPA-DR 4781- One project with six assignments within the Road and Bridge Department is on hold due to lack of funding.
 - e. LCFP- Additional flood water sensors have been added.
13. The Court tabled the setting of the Sheriff and Constable Fees for 2027 after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Scott Weddle.

14. The Court approved the rear end repair with a minimum 36-month warranty not to exceed \$5,000 for Constable Daniels, PCT 3 vehicle; expense will be allocated from the emergency management disaster contingencies (501014040495) after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor.

15. The Court will pursue further claims through American National Leasing to increase the reimbursement on the claim from Texas Association of Counties after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor.

The Court entered into recess at 12:32 p.m. and reconvened into the open meeting at 1:20 p.m.

16. The Court approved and Interlocal Agreement with Falls County for the housing of inmates at a daily rate of \$76.00 after a motion by Commissioner Scott Weddle and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham. (Attached) (Need fully executed agreement)

17. The Court awarded the bid for lease of real property located at 712 Bridge Street to Aycock Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$1000 per month after a motion by Commissioner Scott Weddle and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham. (Attached)

18. The Court authorized a notice of termination be issued to Curative and table until the next regular scheduled meeting being June 28, 2026 after a motion by Commissioner Scott Weddle and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews.

19. The Court voted to pay bills in the amount of \$612,363.73 after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor. (Attached)
