The Coryell County Commissioners' Court convened at 9:02 a.m. with all members present. County Judge Roger Miller gave the invocation and led the Pledge to the American and Texas Flags.

 - a. The Court accepted the June 2026 Financial Summary report from the County Judge's Office.
 - b. The Court accepted the minutes for the Historical Commission meeting held on June 10, 2026.
 - c. The Court accepted the continuing education transcript for the Tax Assessor Collector.
 - d. The Court approved the minutes for the Commissioners' Court meeting held on July 14, 2026.

The consent agenda was approved with the correction of changing the second "a." to "d." after a motion by Commissioner Ryan Basham and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor.

6. Justin Latham, Road and Bridge Administrator, gave an update.

7. The Court approved the Moody CR 340 Estates plat contingent upon the permitting and clearing of the fence row on CR 312 and that the plat is not filed in county records until completed after a motion by Commissioner Ryan Basham and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews.

8. Discussion/update was held regarding IT Services.

9. Updates on grants were given:

- a. HMP- The Court selected and approved the de minimis rate of 15% for the use of indirect and in-kind work after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor.
- b. RCP- No new updates.
- c. CDBG-MIT- GLO is still working on plans, they are hoping to have them done by the end of August.
- d. FEMA RPA-DR 4781- No new updates.
- e. LCFP- No new updates.

10. The Court approved the application for Unclaimed Property Capital Credits for Counties and authorized the County Judge to submit the application; if funds are received all expenditures of those funds shall be approved by the Commissioners' Court after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ryan Basham.

11. The Court approved the setting of the Sheriffs and Constable fees for 2027 as presented after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor.

12. The Court awarded the bid for RFP #26-01 Fully Insured, Level Funded Medical Benefits to Baylor Scott and White Premier after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor.

13. The Court accepted the donation of the Travis Letter to be placed at the Leon Street Annex on a temporary base with a dedication in February 2027 and Commissioner Ryan Basham serving as the point of contact for placement after a motion by Commissioner Scott Weddle and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews.

14. The Court voted to pay bills with the addition of a Corwin Tile and Carpet invoice for \$10,000, changing the total bills paid from \$713,144.86 to \$723,144.86 after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Keith Taylor. (Attached)

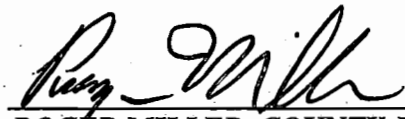

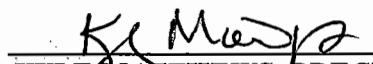
17. No executive session was conducted.

18. No action was taken regarding the settlement against Coryell County and the Coryell County Sheriff's Office.

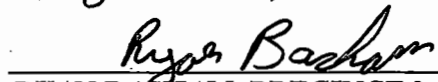
