The Court reconvened into open meeting at 1:32 p.m.

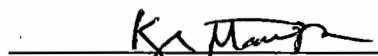
16. No action taken regarding actions to settle a claim against Coryell County and the Coryell County Sheriff's Office.

17. The Court entered into a budget workshop at 1:41 p.m. for discussion concerning proposed budget for FY2027.

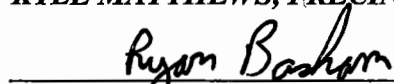

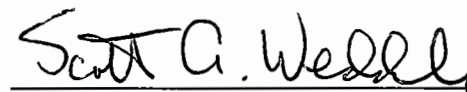

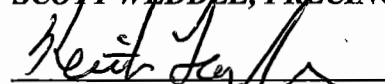
KYLE MATTHEWS, PRECINCT 1



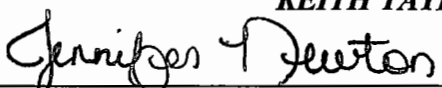
RYAN BASHAM, PRECINCT 3
